Location

Inverclyde Royal Hospital is located approximately 2 miles south west of Greenock town centre.

Walking and Cycling

There is a good network of pedestrian and cycling routes connecting Inverclyde Royal Hospital to neighbouring communities and Branchton rail station. There are shared access routes to the hospital with designated cycle parking located on the campus.

By bus

By rail

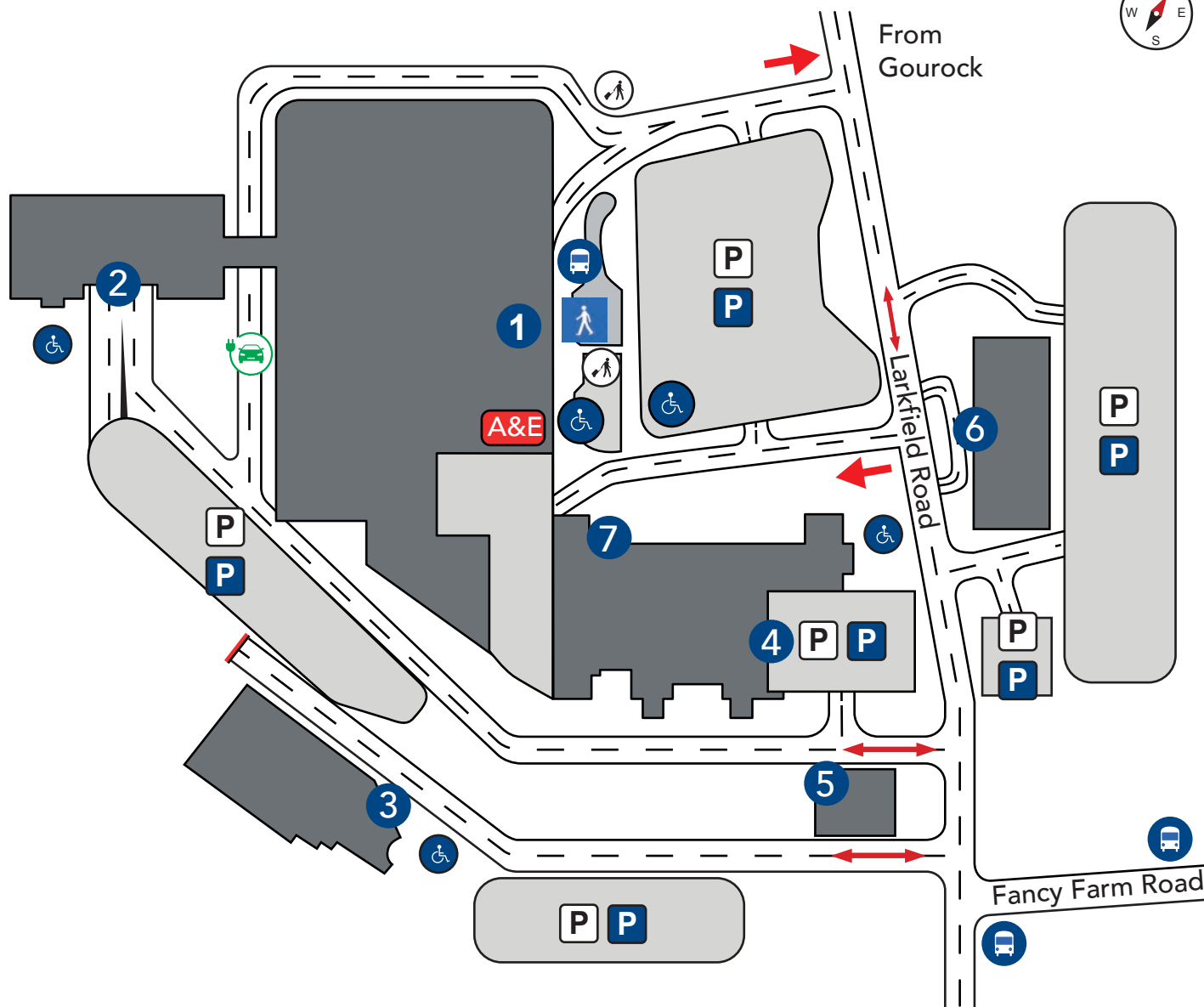
Car Parking

Patient and visitor parking is available in front of the main hospital entrance, with additional parking capacity at the overflow car park, directly across from the site. There is step free access and a pedestrian crossing from the overflow car park to the main hospital entrance. Both car parks, and surrounding areas, can be busy, particularly at peak times, so please consider other travel options such as the bus or train.

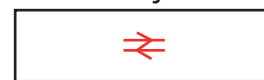
