Campus overview

The Royal Alexandra Hospital is located approximately 1.5 miles from Paisley Town Centre. The map overleaf details where the major departments are located to allow easy access to your appointment. More information is available from our website and the contact number above.

Walking and Cycling

Cycling is a great way to travel to the hospital, if able, especially for visitors and staff. There are shared access routes to the hospital with designated cycle parking located on the campus. The site also benefits from its proximity to National Cycle Routes 7 and 75. There is an excellent network of pedestrian and cycling facilities connecting Royal Alexandra Hospital to neighbouring communities and Paisley Town Centre.

By Rail to Hospital

Paisley Canal:

Approximately 1 mile from the main hospital entrance.

Paisley Gilmour Street:

Approximately 1.5 miles from the main hospital entrance. McGill's 10, 17 and 20 buses operate direct to the main hospital entrance.

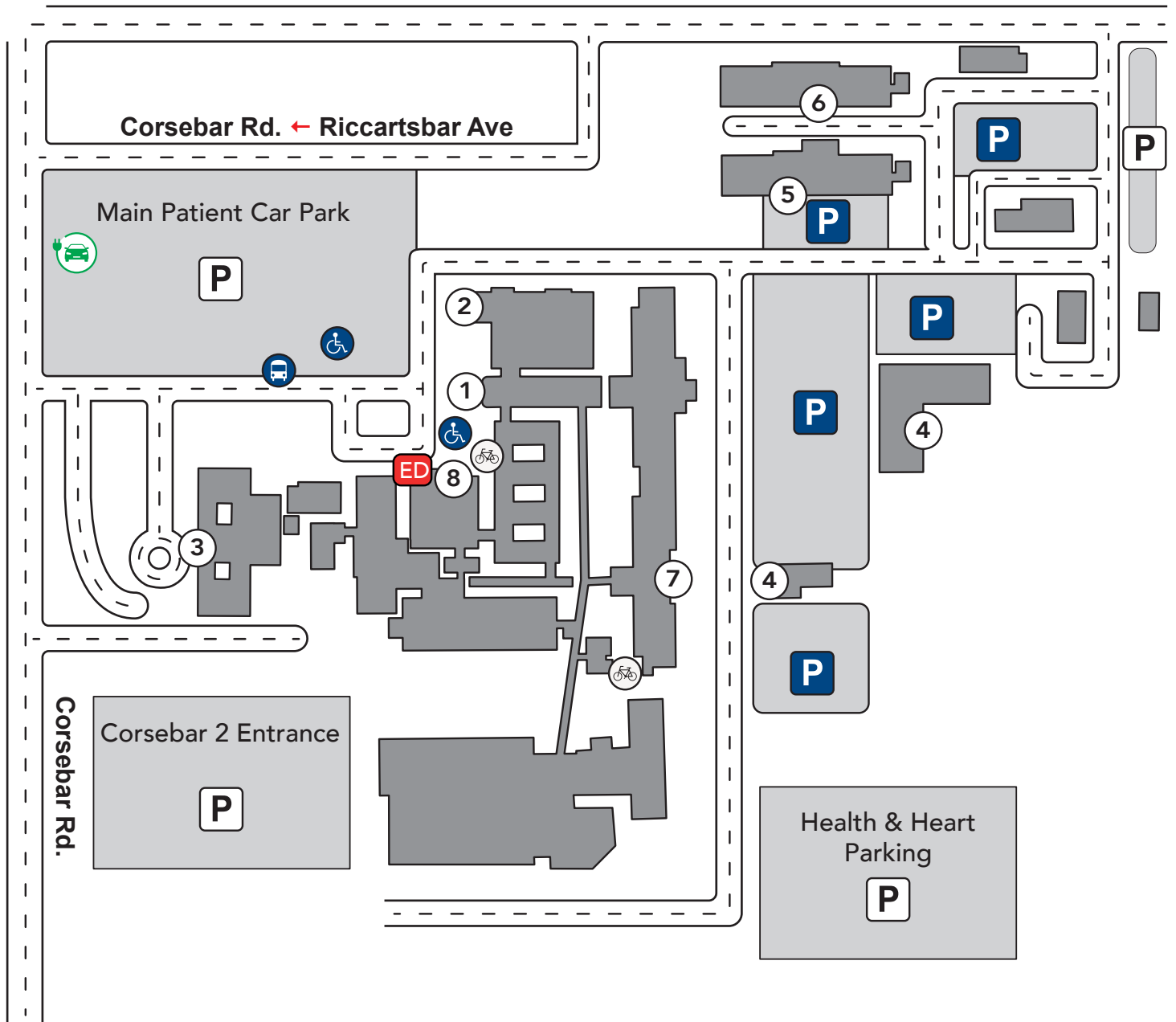
By Car

The hospital has good connections from all major towns across Renfrewshire. The main entrance for vehicles is from Corsebar Road.

Car parking and Blue Badge parking

There are drop off and pick bays in the hospital grounds for main department entrances. Patient and visitor car parking is available, but car parks and surrounding areas are often busy, so please consider other travel options such as bus or train, if they are a suitable alternative. Car parking is free, but there is a 4-hour maximum stay. There are dedicated areas at the main entrance for patients and visitors, including blue badge spaces. Car Park attendants are available to provide advice if required.
