C : EQUALITY DATA-SET (as at end of March 17)

Data Collection by Protected Characteristic

NHSGGC captures equality data in the main through the equal opportunity data set during recruitment. A range of “protected characteristic data” is collected at this stage and analysed quarterly as part of the Staff Governance monitoring process. The level of disclosure of personal sensitive data varies by protected characteristic and figures for both December 2016 and March 2017 are shown below. The figures below do not include those people who opted for ‘Prefer not to say’.

2. EMPLOYEES BY PAY BAND

Ethnicity

Within Senior Pay Bands (Bands 8A-D & 9), 96.76% of staff who disclosed their ethnicity belong to the “White” category.

This is in line with staff in Pay Bands 1-7, where 96.71% of those who disclosed their ethnicity would be categorised as “White”.

Within non-AfC grades, this percentage falls to 80.83%, with the next biggest Ethnic group being Indian (7.19%).

These figures are in line with information presented in the last report.
