Lone Workers – Activate an Amber Alert!

Reliance Protect Lone Worker Device - Action required!

An Amber Alert must be activated in the month of February.

Those devices that are not activated will be placed onto a list for reallocation.

Where departments no longer require the device, risk assessments and procedures must be updated to reflect this and contact made with Health & Safety to ensure the device, charger and any accessories are returned.

New Clydebank Health and Care Centre opens

The new, £21.7million Clydebank Health and Care Centre opened its doors yesterday, heralding a new era in healthcare for the local community.

Situated in the shadows of the iconic Titan crane, the stunning building will give people in Clydebank access to a wide range of health and social care services under one roof for the first time.

The ambitious Queen's Quay project has been delivered by NHSGGC, West Dunbartonshire HSCP and West Dunbartonshire Council in partnership with hub West Scotland and the Scottish Futures Trust. Funding has been provided by the Scottish Government.

Speaking at the opening, our Chairman, Professor John Brown CBE said: "This stunning new facility is the sixth new Health and Care Centre to be opened by NHSGGC and partners in the last few years. It has been delivered on budget and exceeds all of our expectations. In spite of challenging circumstances

brought about by the pandemic, the contractor, design team and project team were able to deliver the building with just a minimal delay.

“I have every confidence that the people of Clydebank will be equally pleased with the result when they start coming through the doors.”



New Functionality in Near Me - 'Consult Now'

Near Me has new functionality - Consult Now. Consult Now allows providers to instantly start a single-use video call by entering the caller's mobile phone number or email address. The Consult Now tab is displayed in the Waiting Area page, allowing providers to start and manage Consult Now calls.

The new Consult Now feature has now been enabled on all existing NHSGGC Near Me waiting areas.
