HNC in Healthcare Practice/Pre-registration Nursing NHSGGC endorsed route

An exciting opportunity has arisen for NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde Nursing (NHSGGC) Healthcare Support Workers to become Registered Nurses (Adult, Child, Learning Disability and Mental Health) by undertaking a Higher National Certificate in Healthcare Practice at a local Further Education Institution and articulating into year 2 of a pre-registration nursing programme at Glasgow Caledonian University or the University of the West of Scotland.

Entry requirements:

- 12 months continuous service with NHSGGC in a substantive nursing HCSW role working a minimum of 25.0 hours per week in this role
- Two Highers at Grade C or above including English; or SCQF Level 6 NC/NQ in a health or care-related subject; or one Higher, preferably English, plus Foundation Apprenticeship in care; or other equivalent qualifications and experience
- Applications are also invited from individuals with no formal qualifications. These applicants will be considered on an individual basis and you may have to undertake an additional written activity
- Statement in support of application from your line manager, authorisation from budget holder, and another satisfactory reference
- Evidence of good communication and numeracy skills
- A commitment to a three-year programme of study
- Eligible to access public funding.

The application deadline closes on Friday 28 March 2025. Please ensure you read the information booklet carefully before you submit an application. In person interviews are expected to take place at Glasgow Caledonian University or the University of the West of Scotland week beginning 5 May 2025.
