Frequently Asked Questions

- Q1 Are there lifts in the Teaching and Learning Centre?
A1 Yes, lifts are immediately ahead to the right as you enter the building.
- Q2 How do I access the building if I am a wheelchair user?
A2 There is a touch pad at the entrance which will allow entry.
- Q3 Will my dietary requirements be catered for?
A3 All dietary requirements stated during the booking process have been passed onto the venue.
- Q4 What if I have accessibility needs for the Lecture Theatre sessions?
A4 Seats on the ground floor front row have been reserved by name for speakers and those requesting it. If you need a reserved front row seat, please email ggc.staffexperience@ggc.scot.nhs.uk
- Q5 What are my breakout sessions?
A5 These were confirmed via email, along with the room location for each – a map is on the reverse of the [event programme](#). If you need a reminder, please ask at the dedicated enquiries desk immediately after signing in.
- Q6 Is there a quiet space if I need it?
A6 Yes, Room L-005 (marked on the event programme) has been dedicated a quiet space.
- Q7 Are there accessible toilets?
A7 Yes, these are marked with a wheelchair icon on the event programme.

A8 Event staff will be on hand to answer questions throughout the venue.
