Future Care Planning Clinical Portal Update

We are delighted to hear from e-Health that the recent proposed changes to the Future Care Planning Summary on Clinical Portal will be ready to go live in the New Year (we will let you know when this happens).

Updates will include:

- Document name change to 'Future Care Plan'
- Inclusion of a question about Treatment Escalation Plans during hospital admissions
- Verification of Power of Attorney
- Re-wording of some section headings/questions to make them more user friendly
- Amendments/additions to Triggers, Job Family and Sector 'drop downs'

We will also be updating our PDF summary and other guidance documents to reflect these changes when they happen.

We will be in touch with everyone once they changes have been made to let you know any steps you need to take to ensure information on the old style of forms can be safely transferred to the new version..



NHSGGC DNACPR Policy Review



Just before the end of last year, a small working group was set up to review the NHSGGC DNACPR Policy. This policy sets out when conversations about cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) should happen, and who should be involved.

There are some situations when CPR would not be a beneficial treatment, but it is important that we have conversations with individuals and the people that matter to them so that everyone understands why CPR may or may not be suitable.

One of the key messages we want to highlight is that conversations about CPR should be part of wider shared decision making conversations which can be documented in Future Care Plans or a Treatment Escalation Plan, and should never happen in isolation. We will let you know when the new policy is published.


