Non acute hospitals have low numbers of infections and are therefore reported all together rather than separately. In NHSGHC this covers Dykebar, Gartnavel Royal, Leverdale, Lightburn, New Stobhill, New Victoria & Orchard View (IRH).

\*\* CDI specimens taken in people who are not a hospital in-patient e.g. GP specimens, Care homes, Hospices etc.
